- Evaluates the effectiveness of Highway Small Groups, Large Group, and FamJamz
- Works with Family Ministry Director to provide Godly counsel to children and their parents throughout the Start Up Kids process
- Proposes and oversees Elementary budget in coordination with Campus Pastor and Family Ministry Operations Associate
- Assists with planning and executing Elementary and Family Ministry special events
- Participates in monthly Family Ministry Team meetings
- Develops authentic relationships with other Ministerial Staff for mutual ministry and personal support
